Emergency Shelter

LCIH has a 15-Bed Emergency Shelter where a single woman or a woman and her children can access a safe place to stay, free from violence and abuse. The shelter offers a number of resources for women and children. The stay is voluntary and there is no cost to access the shelter and its services.

Counselling

LCIH follows a Harm Reduction, Anti-Racist. Anti-Oppression approach in the counselling services offered that is rooted in respecting women's choices.

Safety Planning

LCIH works with each person to ensure safety planning is right for their needs. LCIH supports women and works with them in the creation of their individual safety plan.

Systems Navigation

LCIH supports women as they go through different systems by advocating, referring, and in some instances accompaniment to appointments. Examples include: finances, housing, and the legal system.

Community Outreach Services

LCIH outreach support services are offered to women who have experienced abusive relationships. All services are free and confidential. This support includes:
